Name of the scholarship

Mitrajaya Scholarship (MS)

Purpose

As part of our Corporate Social Responsibility effort, Mitrajaya grants scholarships every year to the needy to enroll to local and private universities throughout the country.

MS is set up to provide funds, grants, financial assistance and support to assist the individuals to realize their academic aspirations.

Programmes Applicable

Applicable for Pre-U, matriculation or foundation or professional course & undergraduate programmes only.

Eligibility

To be eligible for the MS, an applicant must:

- Be a Malaysian citizen
- Genuine financial *need* and good academic results. Have one or more of the following:
 - SPM with minimum 6As including mathematics and two of the science subjects
 - STPM or A Level with grade A for a minimum of two subjects
 - Matriculation with a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.2 and above
 - Foundation - CGPA of minimum 3.2
 - For university undergraduates, a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.2 is required
- Malaysian who has gained admission to a local government school or college (for pre-u or matriculation course), government or private university/institute of higher learning.
- Be a full-time student in a local government school or college (for pre-u or matriculation course) or professional body and local university studying in the fields of Civil Engineering, Electrical and Electronics Engineering, Mechanical Engineering, Computer Science/Engineering, Information Technology, or Computer Engineering, Finance or Accounting, Quantity Survey and any other fields recognized by Mitrajaya.
- Not hold any other scholarship from other companies, organizations, Jabatan Perkhidmatan Awam (JPA), Universities or colleges, Associations or Individuals.
- Perbadanan Tabung Pendidikan Tinggi Nasional Malaysia (PTPTN) loan holders are allowed to apply.
- Possess a dynamic personality, excellent communication skills and hold leadership positions in extra-curricular activities.
- Scholarship recipients will be required to serve the Mitrajaya Group of Companies upon graduation at various locations in Malaysia. Bond period will depend on scholarship amount. Recipients will be able to Partnership with a senior employee to mentor and guide your studies and career planning

- Gross household income of the applicant and his/her spouse or the parents / guardian shall not exceed RM120,000.00 per annum (excluding bonus and incentive)
- Selection of scholarship recipient is at the sole discretion of the Mitrajaya's Management.
- The scholarship holder is required to do internship training with Mitrajaya

Note: Household income = Total income of both the individual and his/her spouse income or the total income of the parents/guardian.
